(Bel Air, MD, April 24, 2008) The Harford County Sheriff's Office is pleased to announce the formation of a Harford County Sheriff's Office Exploring program in partnership with the Boy Scouts of America through its Learning for Life Exploring program. Exploring is "Learning for Life's" career education program for young men and women age 14 to 20 year olds. Explorer's purpose is to provide experiences to help young people mature and prepare them to become responsible and caring adults while investigating the meaning of interdependence in their personal relationships and communities. The four specific goals for Explorer's program is to: 1) gain practical experience in the career interest of the post, 2) engage in program activities centered on the five emphasis areas (*career opportunities, life skills, citizenship, character education, and leadership experience*) to encourage the development of the whole person, 3) experience positive leadership from adult and youth leaders and have the opportunity to take on leadership roles and 4) have a chance to learn and grow in a supportive, caring and fun environment.
